Get your eyes examined!

Do not delay getting your precious eyes tested.



Eye diseases are very common, especially as people are getting older, and can cause blindness if they are not treated early.



Do not add to your disability: everyone needs to have an eye check-up at least once a year. Zonal Hospitals in Kabba and Ankpa provide eye care to everyone, particularly people with disabilities.



You do not have to wait until you have a symptom before going to a hospital eye clinic. It is important to maintain your eyesight, and to seek help for any eye conditions, to prevent sight loss.

How to get your eyes checked

The Zonal Hospital in Ankpa or Kabba both have walk-in eye clinics, open from 9am to 3pm.

When you arrive at the hospital, you will need to buy a hospital card for a small fee at the reception. The receptionist will then give you directions to the eye clinic. There are also signs to the eye clinic to help you find it.

When you get to the eye clinic, you will have your eyes examined by a doctor. If you require surgery, do not despair! The cost of an operation has been greatly reduced by the Kogi State government to make it affordable for you.
